

*NEOPARANTHROTES BORUMANDI* gen. and sp. n. from Iran

## SUMMARY

**Genotypus** : *Neopara nothrotes borumandi* n. sp.

### **Description of n. genus Neoparanthrotes**

Body and head mostly rugulose and covered with callosities.

Vertex in both sexes narrow, its width between eyes, in the male less than one time and in the female less than 1.45 times wider than transverse diameter of an eye. Fastigial furrow present. Median carina of pronotum weak with a median longitudinal sulcus, hardly noticeable, never intersected by the transverse groove.

Tympanum well developed. First two abdominal tergites simple, without sharp posterior apical spine. Prosternum with a distinct median pointed and conical process.

Body entirely apterous. Hind femur with small denticles on the dorsal margin. Empodium of the tarsi more or less wide, small, hardly reaching the middle of the claws.
